Behaviour Code Overview

The Lyndoch Primary School Behaviour Code is based on our agreed school values of Respect, Self responsibility, Resilience and Collaboration.

Our students need to develop habits that show that they can:

Think First

• individuals will be responsible and accountable for their own behaviour.

Be Respectful

• students will behave in a manner that demonstrates respect not only for themselves, but also others and property.

Play by the Rules

• all members of our school will be able to work and play in a safe school environment.

We will acknowledge positive behaviour as it occurs in the yard and the classroom. Such acknowledgements could include: stickers / certificates, diary notes, student choice activity time, class awards, recognition at assemblies and praise. Peer Mediators may assist with acknowledging positive behaviour.

We recognise two levels of inappropriate behaviour:

- Minor behaviour which is not deliberate or dangerous to self or others
- Serious or repeated behaviour which is deliberate or dangerous to self or others or is repeated behaviour.

The accompanying pages have statements about our yard and classroom behaviour codes.

Behaviour management works best if there is a supportive approach between the school and the home. We will strive to keep you informed of any issues that arise and we ask that you contact us if there are any concerns that you may have.
